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### Why iQAAPs?

" Currently the collation of metrics and audit findings, undertaken within the Specialist Pharmacy Service (SPS), is maintained on an Excel spreadsheet with limited access.

A more transparent and robust method of data collection is needed to provide a single, centralised view of the status of the aseptic services and promote transparency for the service and public alike."



### PAQ data – facility age




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### PAQ data – clean air device age




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
